

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This coming Saturday, July 29th , marks the one-year anniversary of the installation of our shepherd, Bishop Robert Emmet Barron. He will be attending World Youth Day (WYD) as will I, and we young pilgrims from the Diocese of Winona-Rochester will meet in Portugal to celebrate Mass with our bishop. Perhaps you have come across some recent news about WYD and the Portuguese bishop whose statement raised eyebrows. Our bishop responded to that rather weak statement, in which the Portuguese bishop stated WYD is not about bringing others into the fold but to let the diversity of today's youth follow their respective paths in life. Respectively, that is fine but that is not what WYD is about; it is about encountering Christ! You can read our bishop's wonderful response:

Is it about showing respect only for others' beliefs, which is commendable, or to share our hope, joy, and love we encounter in Jesus Christ our Savior? Why are we afraid to give witness, not in a theological discourse and conversation with others, but simply about who we are as Christians, as Catholics? Is it because we feel inadequate, perhaps not fully formed in our faith? When have we encountered Christ in our lives, in some aspect that we can share because it really was an event of grace from God?

This will be the ninth time I have attended WYD. Granted, as I get older, I say this is for younger priests and not for me. Yet, I will come away with many graces because I am not doing my will. I am called to serve and be of service to the youth who are making a statement by their very presence at this event and who will also receive many graces. I will be rejuvenated in spirit by these young people, open to the working of the Holy Spirit in their lives. I recently saw an article about priests raising funds so that those without the means who want to attend can do so. Some of those priests had experienced the call of their vocations at WYD! They want to be a part of God's plan to touch the hearts and souls of youth searching for meaning, searching for God! These young people want to love and be loved; they are open to this encounter that certainly can change lives.

Please keep WYD in your prayers. We are blessed with a Bishop who is speaking boldly about Jesus because he is a witness as shepherd and teacher, leading us to Jesus through Word and Sacrament. Pray for our bishop. Pray for our Holy Father, Pope Francis, who began his pontificate asking for a moment of silent prayer and then asking all of us to pray for him. It is not easy to be a follower of Jesus today, let alone being a bishop or the Pope. Social media has arisen many "pontiffs", some who are critics and others who seem to have all the answers. We have only one Holy Father, so let's pray for him, that the Holy Spirit will guide his every decision and safeguard the deposit of faith.

We can learn a lesson from today's Gospel. The patience of the field owner (God) allows time for conversion. Let us not be quick to take matters into our own hands and uproot the weeds, to try to eliminate evil by ourselves. Let us pray for the conversion of everyone, including ourselves, and continue the path of ongoing conversion. God Love You!!!


