Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Blaise Pascal was born in 1623 and this marks the fourth centenary of his birth. Pope Francis issued on June 19th, the day of Pascal's birth, an Apostolic Letter, *The Grandeur and Misery of Man* that is not long but filled with wisdom and knowledge pertinent for our society today. When Pascal had died, found sewn inside his jacket lining was the following:

By Blaise Pascal. The year of grace 1654, Monday, 23 November, feast of St. Clement, pope and martyr, and others.

From about half past ten at night until about half past midnight, FIRE. GOD of Abraham, GOD of Isaac, GOD of Jacob not of the philosophers and of the learned. Certitude. Certitude. Feeling. Joy. Peace. GOD of Jesus Christ. My God and your God. Your GOD will be my God. Forgetfulness of the world and of everything, except GOD. He is only found by the ways taught in the Gospel. Grandeur of the human soul. Righteous Father, the world has not known you, but I have known you. Joy, joy, joy, tears of joy. I have departed from him: They have forsaken me, the fount of living water. My God, will you leave me? Let me not be separated from him forever. This is eternal life, that they know you, the one true God, and the one that you sent, Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ. I left him;



I fled him, renounced, crucified. Let me never be separated from him. He is only kept securely by the ways taught in the Gospel: Renunciation, total and sweet. Complete submission to Jesus Christ and to my director. Eternally in joy for a day's exercise on the earth. May I not forget your words. Amen.

These words that capture an event in his life have become known as the "night of fire". Pascal has become famous for his sayings that were collected and compiled into a book years after his passing, entitled *Pensées*. He saw the balance between faith and reason, of which Pope St. John Paul II would refer to in his encyclical, *Faith and Reason*. I highly recommend that we take some time this summer delving into some of these great writings offered to us from the Church and the many great works of the saints. Please make use of FORMED as well, filled with so many resources, especially in video format, films and documentaries and other tools that help us grow in the faith and love of Jesus Christ. How I wish we all would have these special moments of grace like Blaise Pascal and allow the love of God to overwhelm us!!! Wishing everyone a safe and restful 4th of July!
