

Stations of the Cross will be held several times each week. Everyone is welcome to attend these many opportunities to meditate on the suffering and death of Our Lord. The prayers for the **Way of the Cross** published by St. Alphonsus Liguori in 1761 are among the most well-known. In his brief introduction to this devotion he wrote: "The pious exercise of the Way of the Cross represents the sorrowful journey that Jesus Christ made with the cross on His shoulders, to die on Calvary for the love of us. We should, therefore, practice this devotion with the greatest possible fervor, placing ourselves in spirit beside Our Savior as He walked this sorrowful way, uniting our tears with His, and offering to Him both our compassion and our gratitude." "A plenary indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly make the Stations of the Cross under the usual conditions of confession, communion, and a prayer for the Pope's intentions." (Handbook of Indulgences, #63)



At all of the Masses this weekend February 24-25, I will be inviting you to prayerfully consider what financial gift you can sacrifice to support Bishop Barron's 2024 Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal. Every registered parishioner should have received in the mail a brochure, a pledge card, and a return envelope. If you have not received a personal pledge card, extra envelopes and brochures are available at the entrances of the Church. Please return your gift before Easter. You can mail your contribution directly to the diocese, or put your envelope in the collection basket during any weekend Mass. The Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal supports Bishop Barron's Catholic ministries throughout our diocese including: Catholic Schools; Marriage and Family Life; Faith Formation (including RCIA and our two Newman Centers); Vocations and Seminarians; Youth Ministry; Hispanic Ministry; Lay Formation; and Communications (including the *Courier* and the televised Sunday Mass). The Bishop has set a goal of \$50,880 for

St. Joseph Parish. If this amount is not raised by the end of the 2024 calendar year, the Bishop requires that the remaining amount is paid in full by the general operating budget of our parish. If a parish exceeds its goal, the Bishop has agreed to return to the parish 100% of any amount over the goal.

The exhibit features accounts of several Eucharistic Miracles that have been recorded throughout the Church's history.



This is always the "last hurrah" before the time of fasting since many of our students give up sweet treats and/or video games during the 40 days of Lent. Fasting, Prayer, and Almsgiving are the 3 pillars of Lent and this is a way for students to be introduced to Almsgiving as well. This year the 7/8th grade students raised \$1,779.00. The proceeds will benefit the OHS Husky Pantry for food, clothing,

hygiene and school supplies for OHS students who qualify for

homelessness, or are just in great financial need.

"Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry"

Beginning March 2nd, our St. Joseph's family is making a dedication to pray for vocations through our new "Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry". The Crucifix travels each week to a different home in our community. While in the home, the Crucifix is displayed and prayers are offered daily for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, deaconate and religious life. Inside the box, is the Crucifix, a simple prayer guide, a journal if you'd like to share a reflection or experience from your week, and a prayer calendar for our diocese which includes the names of our seminarians, priests and deacons. When you return the box with the Crucifix to the Sacristy at St. Joseph's Church before the 4pm Mass the following Saturday, it will then be ready for the next family to pick up at the Mass they attend that weekend.

Sign up sheets will be in the Gathering Space beginning February 10th. Check your calendars to decide when you will be able to participate in this Ministry.

Your prayers are essential for raising up vocations in our Church. It is also essential that religious vocations be encouraged and supported within each family home. As we begin this new ministry, let us recall the words of our Lord: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; ask the Master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest." (Matthew 9:37-38)




