

1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent

Today, on this First Sunday of Lent, February 18, at 3:00 p.m. at Queen of Angels Church in Austin, Bishop Barron will celebrate the **Rite of Election** and the **Call to Continuing Conversion** with the catechumens and candidates of the Diocese of Winona who will be received into full communion with the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Please remember to keep them in your prayers as the catechumens prepare to be baptized, and as both catechumens and candidates prepare to be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation, and receive the Lord's Body and Blood in Holy Communion.

The Season of Lent began last week on Ash Wednesday. During this holy season, we prepare to celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus through our works of **prayer**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving**. If you haven't already done so, this First Sunday of Lent is a good time to consider what prayers, sacrifices, and works of mercy you will be doing for the next forty days.

Thursday, February 22, is the **Feast of the Chair of St. Peter**. The chair (*cathedra* in Latin) is an ancient symbol of authority. The Pope, as the successor of St. Peter, has the authority from Christ (c.f. Matthew 16:13-19) to teach infallibly on matters of faith and morality.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday evening during Lent at:

5:15 p.m. Sacred Heart

7:00 p.m. St. Joseph

Everyone is welcome to attend these many opportunities to meditate on the suffering and death of Our Lord. "A plenary indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly make the Stations of the Cross under the usual conditions of confession, communion, and a prayer for the Pope's intentions." (Handbook of Indulgences, #63)

Either before or after Stations of the Cross, everyone is invited to attend the Knights of Columbus **Fish Fry** from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. at the Columbian Center.

Christ the King in Medford will have Stations of the Cross every Wednesday at 7:30 p.m.

There are several **Rice Bowls** and copies of *The Magnificat Lenten Companion* available at the entrances of the church. Please take these items home and use them as a way to come closer to Christ during this Lenten season through **prayer**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving**.

Next Sunday at all the weekend Masses, I will be inviting you prayerfully to consider what financial gift you can sacrifice to support Bishop Barron's 2024 **Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal**. Every registered parishioner should have received in the mail a brochure, a pledge card, and a return envelope. If you have not received a personal pledge card, extra envelopes and brochures are available at the entrances of the Church. Please return your gift before Easter. You can mail your contribution directly to the diocese, or put your envelope in the collection basket during any weekend Mass. The **Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal** supports Bishop Quinn's Catholic ministries throughout our diocese including: Catholic Schools; Marriage and Family Life; Faith Formation (including RCIA and our two Newman Centers); Vocations and Seminarians; Youth Ministry; Hispanic Ministry; Lay Formation; and Communications (including the *Courier* and the televised Sunday Mass). The Bishop has set a goal of \$50,880 for St. Joseph Parish, and a goal of \$10,631 for Christ the King Parish. If these amounts are not raised by the end of the 2024 calendar year, the Bishop requires that the remaining amount is paid in full by the general operating budget of our parishes. If a parish exceeds its goal, the Bishop has agreed to return to the parish 100% of any amount over the goal.

#### **Knights of Columbus Benefit Lenten Fish Dinners**





#### ST. MARY'S SCHOOL NEWS

St. Mary's third graders started their endangered animals unit by reading lots of books about endangered animals and choosing an animal they would like to find out more about. They researched topics like what the animal eats, where it lives, its habitat, why it is endangered, and of course how people are trying to help the animal. They used those notes to write a five paragraph paper! Finally they presented all the information they learned to their families and the second graders who will do it

next year.















"Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry"

Beginning March 2<sup>nd</sup>, our St. Joseph's family is making a dedication to pray for vocations through our new "Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry". The Crucifix travels each week to a different home in our community. While in the home, the Crucifix is displayed and prayers are offered daily for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, deaconate and religious life. Inside the box, is the Crucifix, a simple prayer guide, a journal if you'd like to share a reflection or experience from your week, and a prayer calendar for our diocese which includes the names of our seminarians, priests and deacons. When you return the box with the Crucifix to the Sacristy at St. Joseph's Church before the 4pm Mass the following Saturday, it will then be ready for the next family to pick up at the Mass they attend that weekend.

Sign up sheets will be in the Gathering Space beginning February 10<sup>th</sup>. Check your calendars to decide when you will be able to participate in this Ministry.

Your prayers are essential for raising up vocations in our Church. It is also essential that religious vocations be encouraged and supported within each family home. As we begin this new ministry, let us recall the words of our Lord: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; ask the Master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest." (Matthew 9:37-38)

#### Past and Present Eucharistic Ministers








