

Easter Sunday

As we celebrate Our Savior's glorious **Resurrection** from the dead, I pray that the Risen Lord will fill your souls with joy and new life! Because Easter is the most important day of the year, the Church celebrates Mass every day this week as if it were Easter Sunday morning. We celebrate the Lord's resurrection for eight days (the Easter Octave); daily Mass will be longer like a Sunday Mass and will include the *Gloria*. The Easter Octave concludes on Divine Mercy Sunday.

Next Sunday, April 7, at the 10:00 a.m. Mass at St. Joseph Parish, six of our young people will be receiving their **First Holy Communion**. Practice for the First Communion will take place in St. Joseph Church this Saturday, April 6, at 9:30 a.m. Our seven First Communion candidates and at least one parent are required to attend this rehearsal. At this practice, the first communicants will have an opportunity to confess their sins before receiving the Lord's Body and Blood for the first time.

Next Sunday, April 7, is **Divine Mercy Sunday**. In Poland in 1931, Jesus appeared to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska (+5 October 1938) and asked her to promulgate Divine Mercy Sunday on the first Sunday after Easter. According to Our Lord: "On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open.... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.... Let no soul fear to draw near me, even though his sins be as scarlet." (Diary, #699) Therefore, let no one be afraid to "draw near" to the Lord in the Sacrament of Penance; Christ promises not only complete forgiveness of sins but also complete removal of the temporal punishment caused by our sins!

We will celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday** at St. Joseph Church from 3:00 until 6:30 p.m. We will begin at the "Hour of Mercy," 3:00 p.m., by venerating the Image of Divine Mercy. Then I will expose the Blessed Sacrament and join in the prayerful singing of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. During Adoration, I will hear confessions from 3:30-5:45 p.m. and someone will lead the rosary. At 6:00 p.m. we will pray the *Regina Cæli* and sing Solemn *Vespers*; Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will follow *Vespers*.

The **Novena of Divine Mercy** began on Good Friday and continues through this week. The novena prayers are available in a red-colored pamphlet – *Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet* – located in the narthex.

I would like to take this opportunity to express my sincere gratitude for a beautiful Lenten season:

- Thank you to those people who came to the Stations of the Cross and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Meditating on the suffering and death of Our Lord is my favorite Lenten devotion.
- Thank you to everyone who took the opportunity to make a good confession before Easter. I was inspired by all the many confessions.
- Thank you to everyone who helped make our Sacred Triduum Liturgies so beautiful: our parish staff, musicians, choir members, readers, servers, ushers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, oil bearers, decorators, and sacristans. You all helped to give honor and glory to God.
- Thank you for giving so generously to our various Holy Week collections. The amounts that we collected should be available for next week's bulletin.






3rd ANNUAL MARIAN CONFERENCE THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF CHAMPION
