Everyone is invited to attend the **Chrism Mass** at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, March 25, at Sacred Heart Parish in Heron Lake, Minnesota. At the Chrism Mass, Bishop Barron will bless the three Holy Oils used in the four of the seven Sacraments: **Sacred Chrism** (used in Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders); the **Oil of the Catechumens** (used to anoint a person before they are baptized); the **Oil of the Sick** (used to anoint the sick). The Holy Oils will be brought to the altar on Holy Thursday night.

Many of you might remember the term "**Easter Duty**." A Catholic's "Easter Duty" referred to the obligation to go to confession and receive Holy Communion during the Easter season. This obligation is still in effect! "Catholics are obliged to receive Holy Communion during the Easter season." (*Code of Canon Law, no. 920*) "The Faithful are obliged to confess grave sins at least once a year. It is recommended that venial sins also be confessed." (*Code of Canon Law, no. 988-989*) Therefore, I encourage everyone to make a good confession before receiving Holy Communion on Easter Sunday. Please take advantage of these remaining **times for the Sacrament of Penance**:

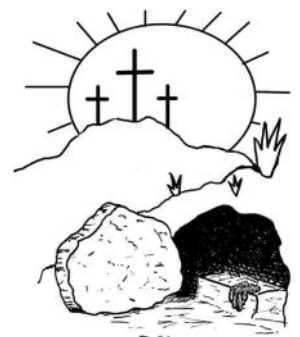

Monsignor Cook's Corner *continued*

A few comments regarding the Sacred Triduum Liturgies:

- At the end of Mass on *Holy Thursday* night, as the Blessed Sacrament is transferred to the Altar of Repose, we imitate Our Lord's procession from the Upper Room to the Garden of Gethsemane. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass and pray; spend some time of silence in the Real Presence of Our Lord. Recall what He said to the Apostles, "*My soul is sorrowful even to death. Remain here and keep watch.*" (Mark 14: 34) The church will remain open until midnight.
- *Good Friday* services will begin and end in absolute silence. Please refrain from talking until everyone is physically outside of the church building on Good Friday.
- *Remember that Good Friday is a day of strict Fast and Abstinence!* Please refer to the regulations concerning fast and abstinence found elsewhere in this bulletin.
- *Good Friday* is also the beginning of the *Novena to Divine Mercy*, which concludes on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, when Our Lord grants the humble penitent complete forgiveness of all sins and punishment. In her diary, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, (+5 October 1938) records what Jesus told her in a private revelation: "*On each day [of the novena] you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My Mercy.... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My Passion, for graces for these souls.... By this novena I will grant every possible grace to souls.*" (Diary, #1209 and #796)
- According to the rubrics of the Roman Missal, the Easter Vigil must begin after nightfall, symbolizing our emergence from complete darkness into the light of Christ.
- Following the ancient biblical tradition, incense will be used at the Holy Thursday Mass, the Easter Vigil, and on Easter Sunday. Father Gregory Leif will be offering Easter Sunday Mass at 9:00 a.m. at Christ the King in Medford; this Mass will be incense-free. "*An angel came and stood at the altar, holding a golden censer. He was given large amounts of incense to offer, along with the prayers of all God's holy ones.*" (Revelation 8:3) "*Let my prayer come before you like incense.*" (Psalm 141:2).

Our Holy Week Collections are as follows:

- ↪ On *Holy Thursday* we will take up the **Rice Bowl Collection**. Please make out one check for your Rice Bowl contribution and put it in an envelope marked *Rice Bowl*. **There will be baskets by the Gathering Hall doors and back entrance of the church that you can put checks and Rice bowls in before the start of Mass. (The Ushers will not be collecting during the Mass)**
- ↪ On *Good Friday* we will take up a collection for the **Holy Land**. Your gifts help to support the holy places where Our Lord was born, lived, died, and rose from the dead.
- ↪ On *Easter Sunday* the collection is for our parishes. Your generous gifts for the **Easter Sunday Collection** are necessary in order to run our parish with a balanced budget. Thank you for your many sacrifices!

Why are the crucifixes and statues veiled?

According to the rubrics of the Roman Missal, crosses and statues are covered during the last two weeks of Lent until the beginning of the Easter Vigil. In his book, *A Handbook on the Liturgy*, Rudolf Peil writes: "On the Fifth Sunday of Lent the crosses in the church are covered with veils. The historical reason for this practice is that in early Christian times these crosses were richly decorated with jewels and precious stones; these were veiled because they were not in harmony with the spirit of the season." Father P. Henry gives a more scriptural interpretation of this custom in his book, *The Liturgical Year*. "Jesus does not appear openly among the people as he did formerly; He remains in hiding: '*Jesus hid Himself*' John 8:59. Hence, the Fifth Sunday of Lent was called *Repus Sunday* meaning 'Hidden Sunday.' Our Lord was compelled to remain hidden; His Divinity was hidden; His images are hidden." The great liturgist Dom Prosper Guéranger, O.S.B., gives this reason: "In order to excite the faithful to a livelier sense of penance, they are deprived of the consolation which the sight of these holy images bring to the soul." In other words, we "fast" from the sight of these holy images during the last two weeks of Lent.

March 24 - Palm Sunday

Today is Palm Sunday and the beginning of the holiest of Christian weeks. Let us pray for the grace to take up our own cross and to follow Jesus through death to new life.

During the months of January and February, through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was able to bring the mercy of Jesus into the hearts of the poor, by assisting 64 adults and 37 children, providing \$175 in food, \$740 for miscellaneous items, \$840 for gas, \$2613 toward rent, \$2152 for utilities, \$160 for Salvation Army vouchers, and \$120 for Furnishing Hope deliveries. On Tuesday we served 140 meals at Vincent's Table.

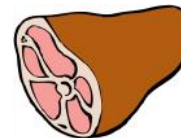

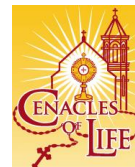

Regulations Concerning Good Friday Fasting and Abstinence

Good Friday is a **Day of Fast and Abstinence**. All Catholics who are between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Good Friday. "Fasting" means limiting oneself to only one full meal. If it is necessary to maintain strength, Catholics may eat two smaller meals that together are not equal to the one full meal. We also fast from eating between meals. All Catholics who are 14-years-old and older are required to abstain from meat on Good Friday. "Parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance." (*Code of Canon Law, #1252*)
