Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Epiphany is the celebration of Jesus' manifestation to the Magi (also known as wise men and kings), who represent the Gentiles or pagan peoples outside of Judaism. This is a solemnity of great importance in the Church, often associated with two other manifestations of the Lord Jesus: the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan and the Wedding at Cana.

The visit of the three wise men represents that salvation has come not only for the Jewish people who awaited the Messiah but also for all peoples. Jesus has become "a light for revelation to the Gentiles", as Simeon prophesied (Luke 2:32). Jesus is made known by the Father's voice from heaven during his baptism (Matthew 3:17; Mark 1:11; Luke 3:22). Lastly, Jesus works his first miracle at "Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory" (John 2:11).

Tomorrow is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the conclusion of the Christmas Season. Tuesday begins Ordinary Time. I hope this was a grace-filled time for you and your families. I am happy that a native son, Fr. Raphael Christianson, OP, was able to celebrate Mass here last week and also this weekend. Please keep him in your good prayers as he is also moving from Washington D.C. to St. Louis to serve the faithful there.

It was certainly a surprise to receive a new assignment outside the regular transition period of July 1st. I will begin on February 1st at St. Pius X Parish in Rochester. As I write this, we are still awaiting word on the new pastor for St. Joseph and Christ the King Parishes. Please keep this in your good prayers as well.

I am having the monstrance refinished (gold plating) at a cost of \$2,175.00. I am looking for any donors for this project. The Third Sunday of Ordinary Time is approaching, and I was hoping to have the project for the Enthronement of the Word completed by then. It is getting near completion, as some have been asking, so let's pray we can see it completed before my departure.

Free Coach Bus Ride to State Capital on January 22

Please join the rally to save the unborn. In 2023, Minnesota lawmakers passed legislation legalizing abortion-up-to-birth. They also repealed a newborn's right to lifesaving treatment. Even more anti-life measures are being considered for 2024. Now is the time to make clear to our elected officials that no child is forgotten, and that moms and babies deserve our protection.
