

6th Sunday of the Year

Today, Sunday, February 11, is the 32nd **World Day of the Sick**. Pope St. John Paul II designated this feast on February 11, the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, because of the many healings that have taken place at the miraculous spring at Lourdes, France, where the Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous.

As noted by the Catholic Health Association of the United States, **World Day of the Sick** has three consistent themes: (1) It reminds the faithful to pray intensely and sincerely for those who are sick. At every Mass we always offer a general "Prayer of the Faithful" for our sick family members and friends; let us also continue to include them in our personal prayers. (2) World Day of the Sick invites Christians to reflect on and respond to human suffering. "If one member suffers, all the members suffer with it." (1 Corinthians 12:26) "I was sick and you visited me." (Matthew 25:36) (3) This day also recognizes and honors all persons who work in health care and serve as caregivers.

Today, Sunday, February 11, is also **World Marriage Day**. In today's modern world, which often attacks the dignity of a life-long marriage between one man and one woman, we honor all of those married couples who are faithful to each other until death, and open to the gift of children. We especially honor those Catholics who faithfully follow the guidelines of the Church regarding marriage. The Lord gives these married couples special graces in the Sacrament of Matrimony to live their vocation and to love each other as Christ loves His bride, the Church.

The Season of Lent begins this week on February 14 with Ash Wednesday. Masses and the imposition of ashes will be at:

7:00 a.m. Sacred Heart

8:10 a.m. Sacred Heart School Mass

12:10 p.m. St. Joseph 5:00 p.m. St. Joseph

During this holy season, we prepare to celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus through our works of **prayer**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving**. Now is a good time to consider what prayers, sacrifices, and works of mercy you will be doing for the next forty days.

Ash Wednesday is a **Day of Fast and Abstinence**. All Catholics who are between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. "Fasting" means eating only one full meal. If it is necessary to maintain strength, Catholics may eat two smaller meals that are not equal to the one full meal. We also fast from eating between meals. All Fridays of the year are **Days of Abstinence** from meat. (Code of Canon Law, #1251) All Catholics who are 14 years old and older are required to abstain from meat on all Fridays of the year. (Outside of Lent the Bishops of the United States have given Catholics permission to substitute another penance in place of not eating meat.) "Parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance." (Code of Canon Law, #1252)

On Ash Wednesday there will be a collection for the **Church in Central and Eastern Europe.** Your gifts will help to rebuild Catholic churches, schools, seminaries, and convents in Eastern Europe that had been destroyed by the atheistic communist government.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday evening during Lent at:

5:15 p.m. Sacred Heart

7:00 p.m. St. Joseph

Everyone is welcome to attend these many opportunities to meditate on the suffering and death of Our Lord. Either before or after Stations of the Cross, everyone is invited to attend the Knights of Columbus **Fish Fry** from 5:00-7:00 p.m. at the Columbian Center. Christ the King in Medford will have Stations of the Cross on Wednesdays at 7:30pm.

There are several copies of *The Magnificat Lenten Companion* available in the Gathering Hall. This booklet contains meditations for each day of Lent. I invite everyone to take a copy home with them; please use these readings as one way to become closer to Christ during Lent.

Rice Bowls and a Home Calendar will also be available. Your daily sacrifices during Lent will be used by Catholic Relief Services to feed the hungry around the world. [Rice Bowls will be collected at Mass on Holy Thursday evening.]

"Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry"

Beginning March 2nd, our St. Joseph's family is making a dedication to pray for vocations through our new "Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry". The Crucifix travels each week to a different home in our community. While in the home, the Crucifix is displayed and prayers are offered daily for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, deaconate and religious life. Inside the box, is the Crucifix, a simple prayer guide, a journal if you'd like to share a reflection or experience from your week, and a prayer calendar for our diocese which includes the names of our seminarians, priests and deacons. When you return the box with the Crucifix to the Sacristy at St. Joseph's Church before the 4pm Mass the following Saturday, it will then be ready for the next family to pick up at the Mass they attend that weekend.

Sign up sheets will be in the Gathering Space beginning February 10th. Check your calendars to decide when you will be able to participate in this Ministry.

Your prayers are essential for raising up vocations in our Church. It is also essential that religious vocations be encouraged and supported within each family home. 
