

Thank you for your generous contributions to Bishop Barron's 2024 Annual Catholic Ministries Appeal. As this bulletin goes to print, we have received \$18,520 toward our goal of \$50,880 for St. Joseph Parish. I am very grateful to the 76 donors who have helped us achieve almost 36% of our goal. We have received \$8,160 toward our goal of \$10,631 for Christ the King Parish; 29 donors have helped us achieve almost 77% of our goal. If you have not yet given to the appeal, I encourage you make a financial gift during this Easter season; extra envelopes and brochures are available in the narthex. You can mail your contribution directly to the diocese, or put your envelope in the collection basket during any weekend Mass. If our parish exceeds its goals, the Bishop has agreed to return to our parish 100% of any amount over the goal.
