

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last Sunday, October 15, was the Memorial of St. Teresa of Avila, also known as St. Teresa of Jesus. We did not celebrate her because Sunday is always the Day of the Lord. Even when we celebrate the life of a saint on the weekdays, it is always about Jesus, whom the saints loved, thus drawing all their strength and guidance from the Good Lord. Pope Francis released on that very day a beautiful apostolic exhortation entitled, "C'est la confiance" ("It is confidence"), "On confidence in the Merciful Love of God for the 150th Anniversary of the Birth of Saint Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face". I believe this work helps explain the pontificate of Pope Francis and his contribution to the new evangelization.

The Holy Father references previous apostolic exhortations, revealing the trouble with Pelagianism or even neo-Pelagianism, which he has observed in some Catholics today. I hope we can all find the time to read this wonderful new document on St. Therese, who is a Doctor of the Church! I would ask all of you then to return to those documents that refer to Pelagianism and Gnosticism, some of the current errors that can be found among today's Catholics. As I mention this, I hope we can examine our own consciences and ask sincerely if we, too, may have fallen into these false concepts of Christianity. I would refer all of us to go to his apostolic exhortation, *Gaudete et exsultate*, the subtitle *New pelagians*, and paragraphs 57-59 to aid us in our examen; add also the reference to *Evangelii Gaudium* paragraph 94. (Pope Francis writes in his new work: "In *Evangelii Gaudium*, I urged a return to the freshness of the source, in order to emphasize what is essential and indispensable. I now consider it fitting to take up that invitation and propose it anew.")

Let me just offer some quotes from this new work on St. Therese.

- 17. ...In place of a Pelagian notion of holiness, individualistic and elitist, more ascetic than mystical, that primarily emphasizes human effort, Therese always stresses the primacy of God's work, his gift of grace. As a result, she could say: "I always feel, however, the same bold confidence of becoming a great saint, because I don't count on my merits, since I have *none*, but I trust in him who is Virtue and Holiness. God alone, content with my weak efforts, will raise me to himself and make me a *saint*, clothing me in his infinite merits".
- 47. This Exhortation on Saint Therese allows me to observe that, in a missionary Church, "the message has to concentrate on the essentials, on what is most beautiful, most grand, most appealing and at the same time most necessary. The message is simplified, while losing none of its depth and truth, and thus becomes all the more forceful and convincing". The luminous core of that message is "the beauty of the saving love of God made manifest in Jesus Christ who died and rose from the dead".

Another passage to pray and reflect upon in sincerity is paragraph 52. There are short lines beginning, "In an age..." and "At a time..." worth pondering in our own heart and soul, honestly asking if we have fallen into these traps.

If we want to get to know the heart and soul of who Pope Francis is, this apostolic exhortation is it. St. Therese and her "little way" is spiritual food for everyone. How blessed we are to have a first-class relic of her as well as her statue, which graces the old baptistry in the back of the church. Her relic is in her actual shrine that Our Lady of Lourdes sits atop. I hope one day to return Therese to her rightful spot and create another appropriate shrine for Our Lady of Lourdes. Let's pray about this as we continue our prayers for peace among all nations and peoples, especially Russia, Ukraine, Palestine, and Israel. Thank you to all who participated in the day of prayer this past Tuesday, despite a last-minute proposal. Thirteen hours of prayer offered before our Sacramental Lord!!!




