Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we begin a new liturgical year with Advent. Universal Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, 39 states: "Advent has a two-fold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight."

The ORDO reminds us: "Advent is a time to recall the cry of the early Christians: *Maranatha!* 'Come, Lord Jesus!'"

How interesting that we end the liturgical year focusing on Christ's Second Coming and continuing with that theme as we begin a new liturgical year. The first three weeks will focus on the Second Coming and preparing our "minds and hearts" to meet Jesus when he comes for us, especially at our death, but also when the end will really arrive for the entire world. Starting on the 17th, we begin the novena to Christmas, and our preparations to celebrate a Christmas season that begins on the eve of the 24th and ends with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 8th, 2024.

My prayer is that this Advent may truly be a moment for every heart to prepare to celebrate the greatest gift, Jesus, whom the Father ardently desires to renew within us daily. Please take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation during Advent, thus making room for the King to reign in our hearts!


