In addition to my assignment as Pastor at Sacred Heart Parish, Bishop Barron has appointed me Parochial Administrator at St. Joseph Parish and Christ the King Parish, until July 1, 2024, by which time, hopefully, a new pastor will be assigned. I am grateful to our Parochial Vicar, Father Parrott, and to our dedicated staffs, as we work together to provide for the sacramental and pastoral needs of the faithful at all three of our parishes. We are honored to serve, and also ask for your patience during the next five months as we minister with one less priest in the Owatonna area. As a general rule, I will be offering the weekend Masses at St. Joseph and Christ the King Parishes every other weekend until a new pastor arrives. I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Father Starasinich for serving as a faithful shepherd for our parishes for the past five years and seven months. He is a good man and a holy priest, and I will miss his wise counsel and collaboration, especially at St. Mary's School and our combined Faith Formation Program. Please pray that Bishop Barron will send a new pastor after Our Lord's own heart: "I will appoint for you shepherds after My own Heart, who will shepherd you wisely and prudently." (Jeremiah 3:15)

In order to allow Father Parrott and me to take a "day away" for rest and prayer, unfortunately it will not be possible to offer Mass at Christ the King Parish on Monday mornings, nor at St. Joseph Parish on Tuesday mornings. There will, however, be Masses at Sacred Heart Parish at 7:15 a.m. on Monday and Tuesday mornings. This revised schedule will allow the weekday morning Masses to remain with as few changes as possible for all three parishes. (Most parishes in our Diocese where a Parochial Administrator has been appointed do not have any Masses whatsoever during the week.) I am grateful for the sacrifices that St. Joseph and Christ the King Parishes are making in the absence of a resident pastor, and we fervently pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood within our Diocese. In the year 2009, we had 115 priests serving in our Diocese; in 2022, the number was sadly reduced to 77. Our Lord reminds us: "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; therefore, ask the Master of the harvest to send our laborers for his harvest." (Matthew 9:37-38)

On Saturday, February 10, at 10:00 a.m. in Sacred Heart Church, 34 of our young people will be making their **First Confession** as they prepare to receive their First Holy Communion in April. Please pray for them as they prepare for this powerful first experience of the Lord's Mercy.

Next Sunday, February 11, is the 32nd **World Day of the Sick**. Pope St. John Paul II designated this feast on February 11, the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, because of the many healings that have taken place at the miraculous spring at Lourdes, France, where the Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous. The theme for this year's Day of the Sick is "It is not good that man should be alone" (Gen 2:18): Healing the Sick by Healing Relationships. In his message on this occasion, Pope Francis writes:

"Brothers and sisters, the first form of care needed in any illness is compassionate and loving closeness. ... Let us commend ourselves to Mary Most Holy, Health of the Sick, that she may intercede for us and help us to be artisans of closeness and fraternal relationships."

Next Sunday, February 11, is **World Marriage Day**. In today's modern world, which often attacks the dignity of a life-long marriage between one man and one woman, we honor all of those married couples who are faithful to each other until death, and open to the gift of children. We especially honor those Catholics who faithfully follow the guidelines of the Church regarding marriage. The Lord gives these married couples special graces in the Sacrament of Matrimony to live their vocation and to love each other as Christ loves His bride, the Church.

This year Ash Wednesday is February 14. According to the *Roman Missal*, the ashes blessed and distributed on Ash Wednesday are made from the palm branches that were blessed on Palm Sunday of the previous year. Over the course of the next ten days, you can bring your **blessed palms** to the parish office; the palms will be burned for Ash Wednesday.

Thank you for your contributions for the **Church in Latin America**. Last weekend, we collected \$335.00. Contributions to this collection support the training of priests, religious, and lay leaders; the education of youth; and other pastoral projects that bring people more fully into the life of the Catholic Church in 23 impoverished countries.

A pastor, servant, and shepherd, leading your flock toward God's Kingdom.



"Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry"

Beginning March 2nd, our St. Joseph's family is making a dedication to pray for vocations through our new "Traveling Vocations Crucifix Ministry". The Crucifix travels each week to a different home in our community. While in the home, the Crucifix is displayed and prayers are offered daily for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, deaconate and religious life. Inside the box, is the Crucifix, a simple prayer guide, a journal if you'd like to share a reflection or experience from your week, and a prayer calendar for our diocese which includes the names of our seminarians, priests and deacons. When you return the box with the Crucifix to the Sacristy at St. Joseph's Church before the 4pm Mass the following Saturday, it will then be ready for the next family to pick up at the Mass they attend that weekend.
