

Divine Mercy Sunday

Today, Sunday, April 7, at the 10:00 a.m. Mass at St. Joseph Parish, seven of our young people will be receiving their **First Holy Communion**. I pray they will always receive the Lord's Body and Blood with love and reverence. "Whoever eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood remains in me and I in him." John 6:56

Today, Sunday, April 7, is **Divine Mercy Sunday**. In Poland in 1931, Jesus appeared to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska (+5 October 1938) and asked her to promulgate Divine Mercy Sunday on the first Sunday after Easter. According to Our Lord: "On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open.... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.... Let no soul fear to draw near me, even though his sins be as scarlet." (Diary, #699) Therefore, let no one be afraid to "draw near" to the Lord in the Sacrament of Penance; Christ promises not only complete forgiveness of sins but also complete removal of the temporal punishment caused by our sins!

We will celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday** at St. Joseph Church from 3:00 until 6:30 p.m. this afternoon. We will begin at the "Hour of Mercy," 3:00 p.m., by venerating the Image of Divine Mercy. Then I will expose the Blessed Sacrament and join in the prayerful singing of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. During Adoration, Father Parrott and I will hear confessions from 3:30-5:45 p.m. and someone will lead the rosary. At 6:00 p.m. we will pray the *Regina Cæli* and sing Solemn *Vespers*; Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will follow *Vespers*.

On Monday, April 8, Holy Mother Church celebrates the **Solemnity of the Annunciation**, when the Archangel Gabriel asked Mary to be the Mother of God. Every day when the church bells ring at 6:00 a.m., noon, and 6:00 p.m., the faithful are invited to pray the *Angelus*, calling to mind the beginning of our Redemption when Our Lord was conceived in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Peter Kreeft says, "The Incarnation is the most astonishing of all God's acts: the most surprising, unforeseeable, unimaginable thing that ever happened.... The Author of all of history stepped into the drama He created and became one of His own characters." (Catholic Christianity, 69) This Solemnity is celebrated every year on March 25 (exactly nine months before Christmas), but when that date falls during Holy Week or the Easter Octave, the Solemnity is transferred to the next available liturgical date – this year on April 8. Father Parrott will offer Mass at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, April 8, at Sacred Heart Church.

Next Sunday, April 14, at the 10:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. Masses at Sacred Heart Parish, 25 of our young people will be receiving their **First Holy Communion**. Practice for the First Communion will take place at Sacred Heart Church this Saturday, April 13, at 9:30 a.m. Our First Communion candidates and at least one parent are required to attend this rehearsal. At this practice, the first communicants will have an opportunity to confess their sins before receiving the Lord's Body and Blood for the first time.

On Wednesday, April 17, at 7:00 p.m. at St. Joseph Church, Bishop Barron will celebrate the **Sacrament of Confirmation** for 42 of our young adults from Sacred Heart, St. Joseph, and Christ the King Parishes. Practice for the Confirmation Mass will take place at St. Joseph Church this Wednesday, April 10, at 6:30 p.m. The *confirmandi* and at least one parent (or sponsor) are required to attend this rehearsal. At this practice, they will have an opportunity to confess their sins before receiving the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Please keep our *confirmandi* in your prayers as they prepare to be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Once again, I want to express my sincere gratitude to everyone who helped make our **Holy Week and Easter Liturgies** so beautiful and inspiring. In addition, thank you for giving so generously to our various Holy Week collections. We received: \$1,131.00 for the Rice Bowl; \$2,378.50 for the Holy Land; and \$14,700.77 on Easter Sunday. Your contributions for the **Easter Sunday Collection** are necessary in order to run our parish with a balanced budget. Thank you for your many sacrifices!
