Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Pope Francis has given us more words to ponder and reflect during last Wednesday's General Audience as he spoke about St. Charles de Foucauld, one of the more recently canonized saints. Let's begin with this paragraph:

And what was the "secret" of Charles de Foucauld, of his life? After living his youth being distant from God, without believing in anything other than the disordered pursuit of pleasure, he confides this to a non-believing friend, to whom, after having converted by accepting the grace of God's forgiveness in Confession, he reveals the reason of his life. He writes: "I have lost my heart to Jesus of Nazareth". Brother Charles thus reminds us that the first step in evangelizing is to have Jesus inside one's heart; it is to "fall head over heels" for him. If this does not happen, we can hardly show it with our lives. Instead, we risk talking about ourselves, the group to which we belong, a morality or, even worse, a set of rules, but not about Jesus, his love, his mercy. I see this in some new movements that are emerging: they talk about their vision of humanity, they talk about their spirituality and they feel theirs is a new path... But why do you not talk about Jesus? They talk about many things, about organization, about spiritual journeys, but they do not know how to talk about Jesus. **I think that today it would be good for each one of us to ask him or herself: "Do I have Jesus at the center of my heart? Have I 'lost my head' a bit for Jesus?"**.

Last week it was St. Therese, who also fell head over heels for Jesus. She did not speak about herself or her "merits" because she said, "I have *none*," but only about Jesus and his love for her. For access to these latest works of the Holy Father, go to:

Let us continue our prayers for Palestine, Israel, the Ukraine, and Russia. It seems that the situation in the Middle East is escalating as we are witnessing protests and demonstrations throughout the world and in our own country. Violence is not the answer! Even for ourselves, I pray that we do not get caught in discussions about war, taking sides with one group or another. Until our hearts have received God's love and grace, we will fall into the vicious cycle of nonstop bickering, arguing, fighting, and even physical harm. Hatred does not come from God, so all people of whatever religion or creed should ponder in their own hearts if their God is really the center of their heart? Unfortunately, we may soon be in the midst of a very serious global conflict. Our Blessed Mother has been warning us through private revelations since the time of the seers of Fatima in 1917 and up until the present time through some apparitions still under church investigation. Mary's message to us has always been **CONVERSION!** Prayer, especially the rosary, is the key, followed by fasting from anything so as to keep us more focused on God. Almsgiving helps us to put our security in God and not money or material possessions, as Jesus has told us (see Matthew 6:24-26). Especially for us Christians, may we heed Jesus' words: "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:34-35). Let us conclude with more of Pope Francis' words:

Saint Charles de Foucauld, a figure who is a prophecy for our time, bore witness to the beauty of communicating the Gospel through *the apostolate of meekness*: considering himself a "universal brother" and welcoming everyone, he shows us the evangelizing power of meekness, of tenderness. Let us not forget that God's style is summarized in three words: closeness, compassion, and tenderness...

So lastly, let us ask ourselves whether we carry within us and to others, Christian joy, Christian meekness, Christian tenderness, Christian compassion, Christian closeness.

God Love You!!!

**November 2, 2023 is All Souls Day, a feast in which we pray for the holy souls in Purgatory.**

In addition to offering Mass and praying for the souls of the faithful departed, the Church also gives us the opportunity to gain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory. A plenary indulgence is “a remission of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church paragraph 1471)

**As the Catechism tells us in paragraphs 1472:**

*To understand this doctrine and practice of the Church, it is necessary to understand that sin has a double consequence. Grave sin deprives us of communion with God and therefore makes us incapable of eternal life, the privation of which is called the “eternal punishment” of sin. On the other hand every sin even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory.*

A plenary indulgence removes all temporal punishment, so for a person on earth it would be as though they had just been baptized. If they died at that moment they would go straight to heaven. The Church also gives us the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence for souls in Purgatory.

**The Catechism says in paragraph 1479:**

*Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the same communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain to indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments for their sins may be remitted.*

Here's how you can obtain a plenary indulgence for souls in Purgatory anytime between November 1-8.

**Visit to a Church or Oratory on All Souls Day** – on visiting the church or oratory it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

**Visit to a Cemetery** - Only applicable to the souls in Purgatory when one devoutly visits and prays for the departed.

In addition to visiting these places and offering the prescribed prayers, the general requirements of indulgences must be met, which are:

\*Pray for the intentions of our Holy Father

\*Worthily receive Holy Communion

\*Go to Confession within about 20 days of the indulgenced work.

\*Be in a state of grace at the time the indulgenced work is completed.

\*For a plenary indulgence it is also necessary to have complete detachment from sin, even venial sin.
